Nondeductible lobbying and political expenditures are described in Internal Code Section 162(e), and include expenditures paid or incurred in connection with (i) influencing legislation; (ii) participating or intervening in any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office; (iii) attempting to influence the general public with respect to elections, legislative matters, or referendums; and any direct communication with a covered executive branch official in an attempt to influence the person's official actions or positions. CAA cannot provide tax advice to its members; always consult your tax advisor.
